National Maternal Mortality Ratios

2011

- Maternal Deaths = **118**
- Live Births = **363415**

(Registrar General's Dept)

$$\bullet \text{ MMR} = \frac{118}{363415} \times 100000$$

= **32.5** per 100,000 live births

2012

- Maternal Deaths = **134**
- Live Births = **355900**

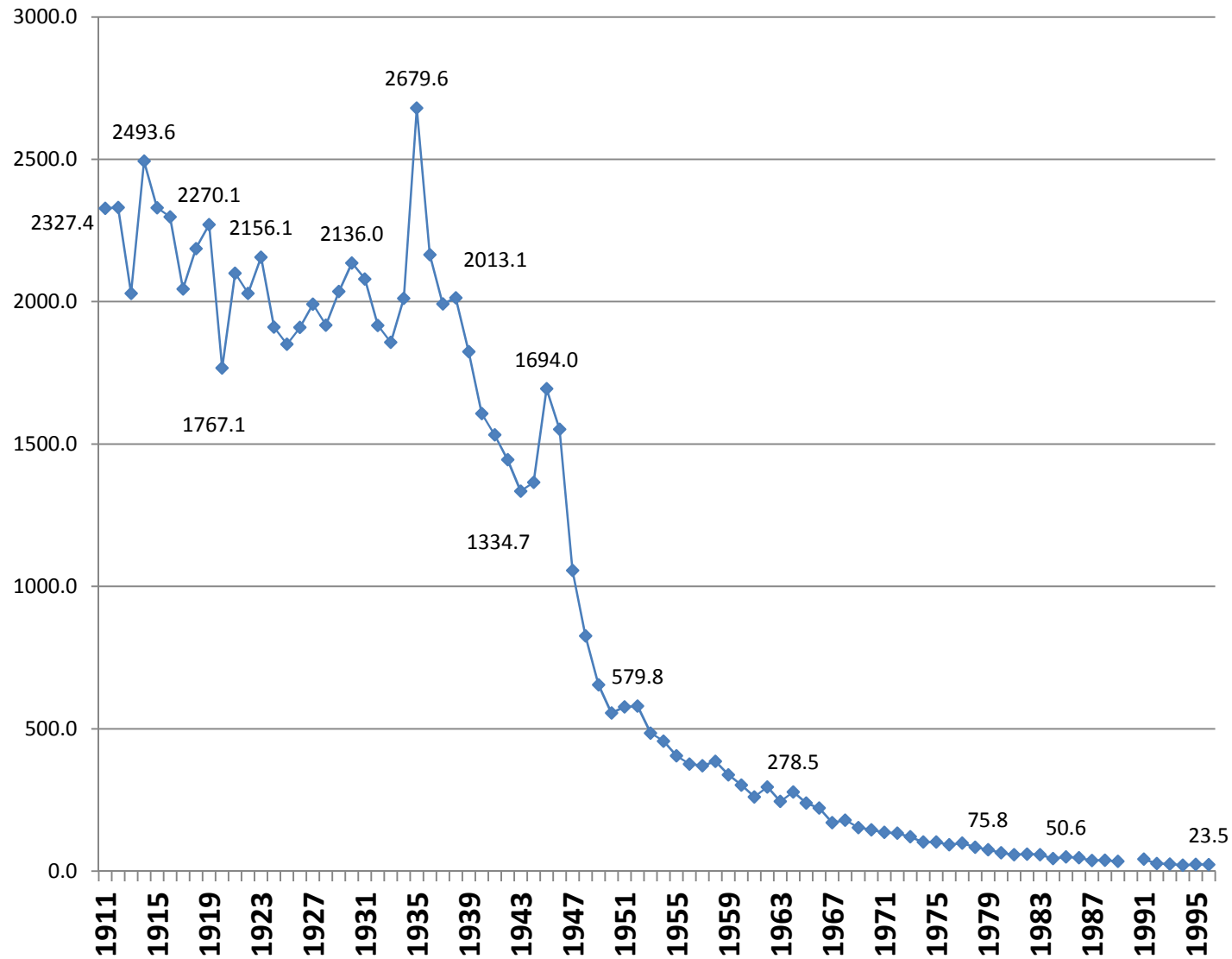

$$\bullet \text{ MMR} = \frac{134}{355900} \times 100000$$

= **37.7** per 100,000 live births

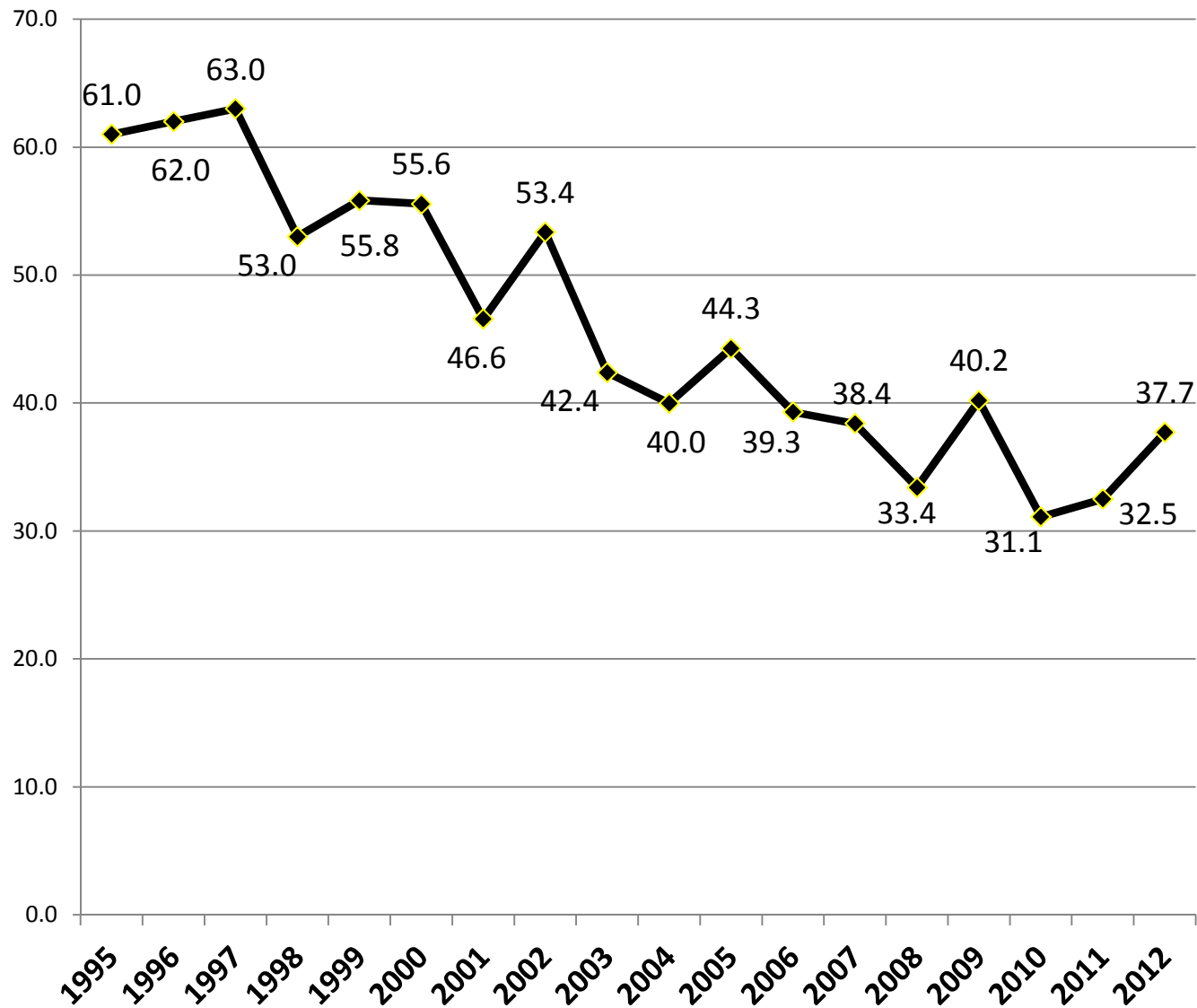
Maternal Mortality Ratio 1911 – 1995

Maternal Mortality Ratio 1995 - 2012

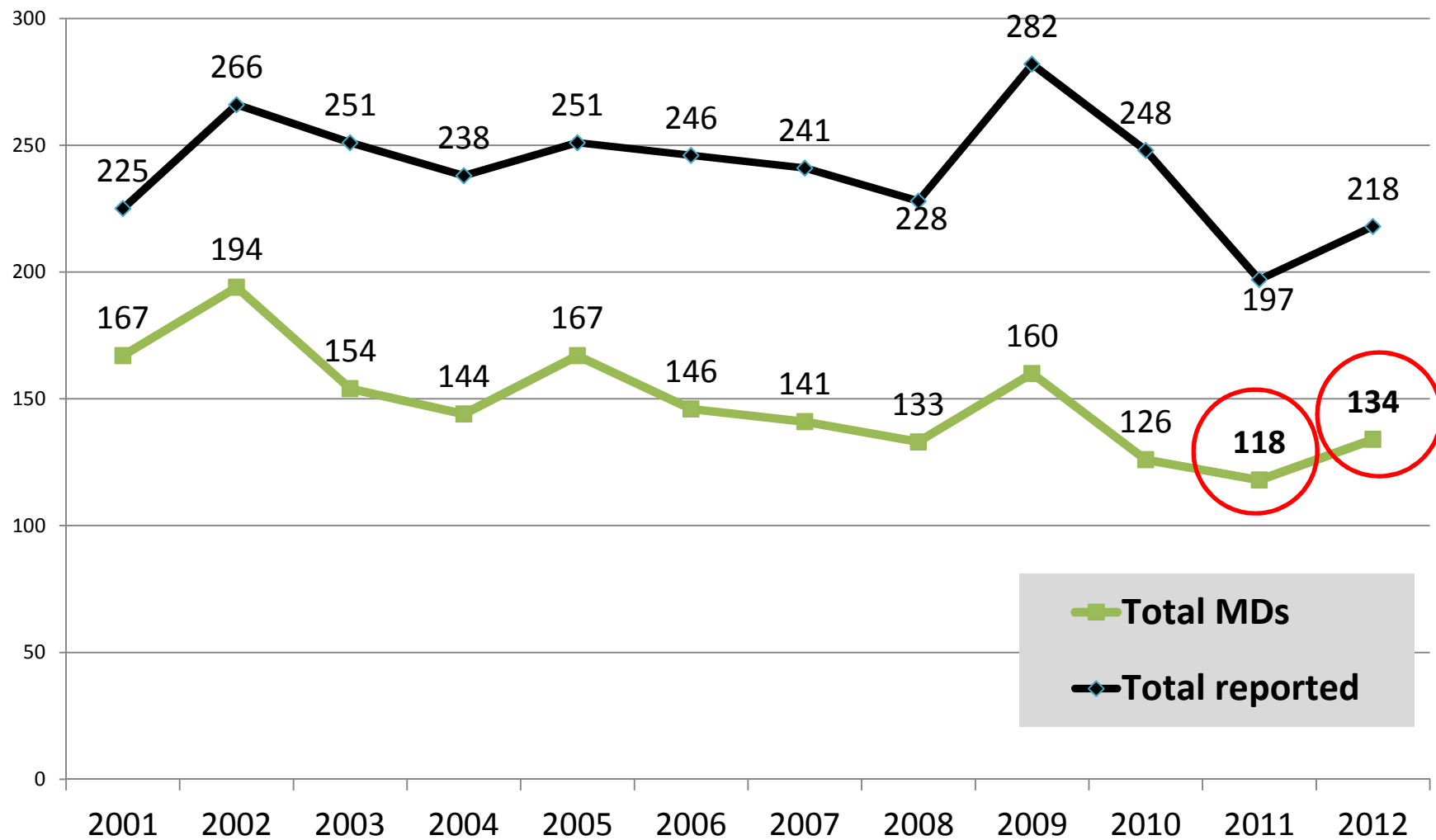

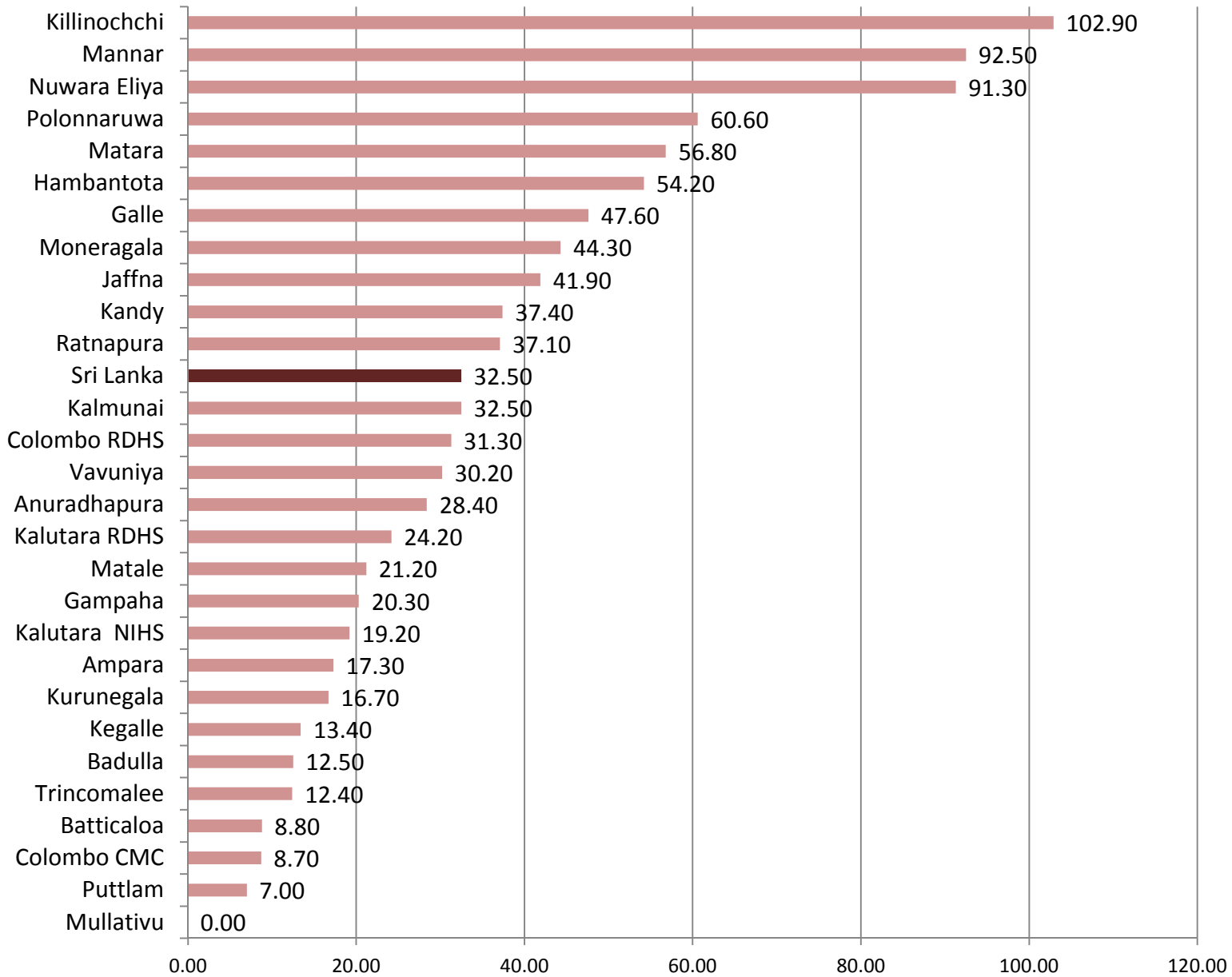
Number of Reported Deaths & Maternal Deaths

(2001 – 2012)



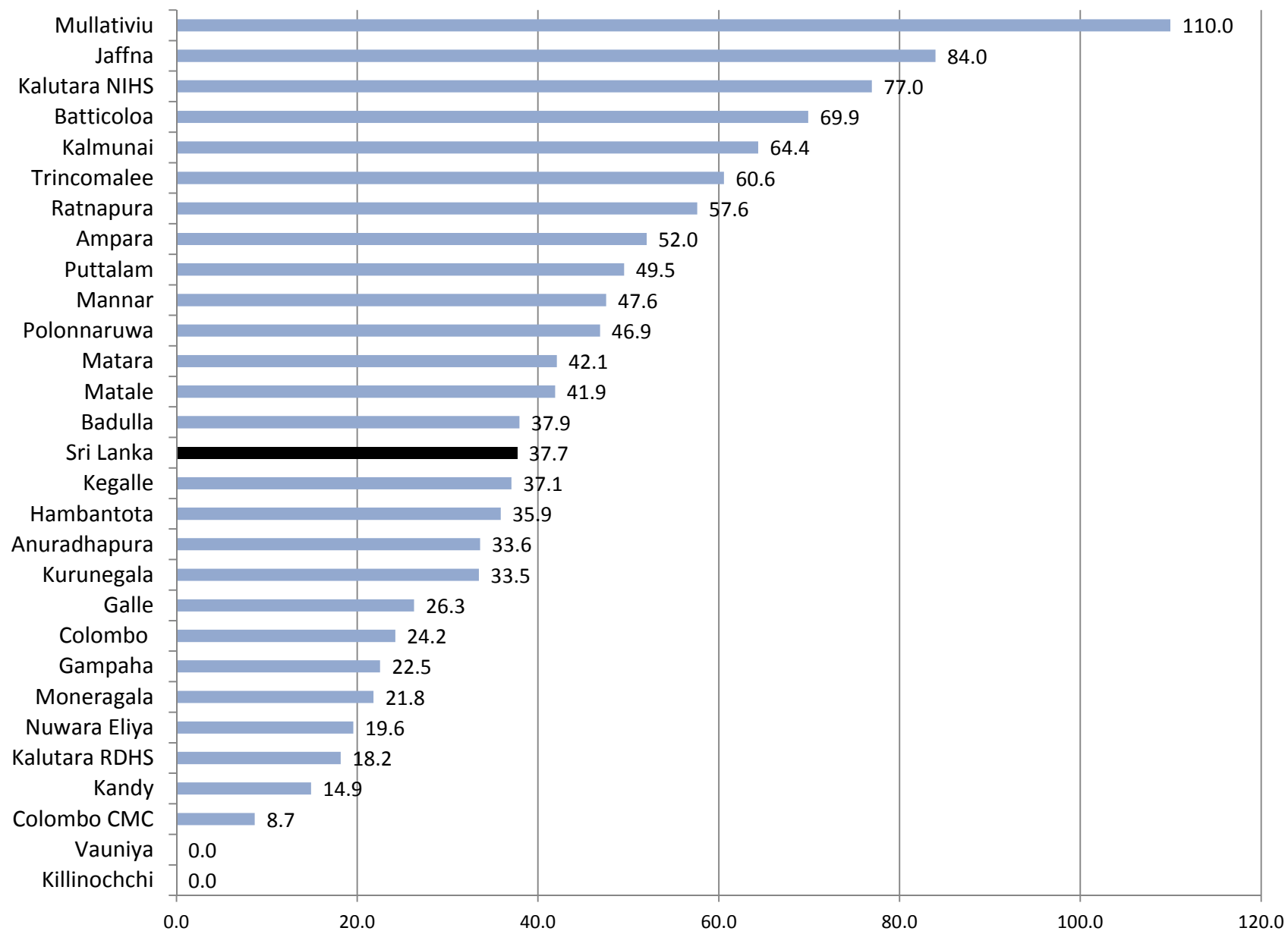

District MMR - 2011



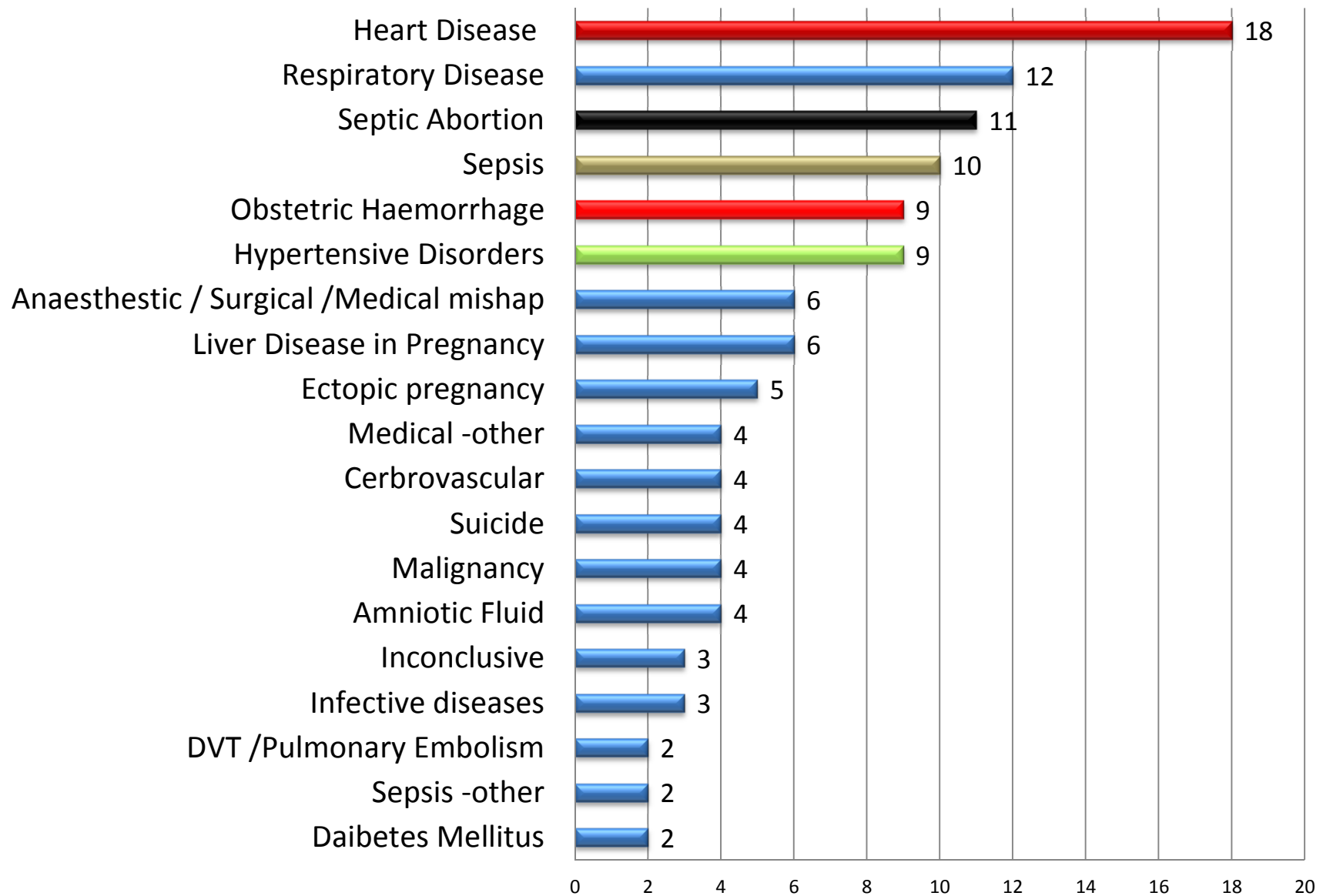

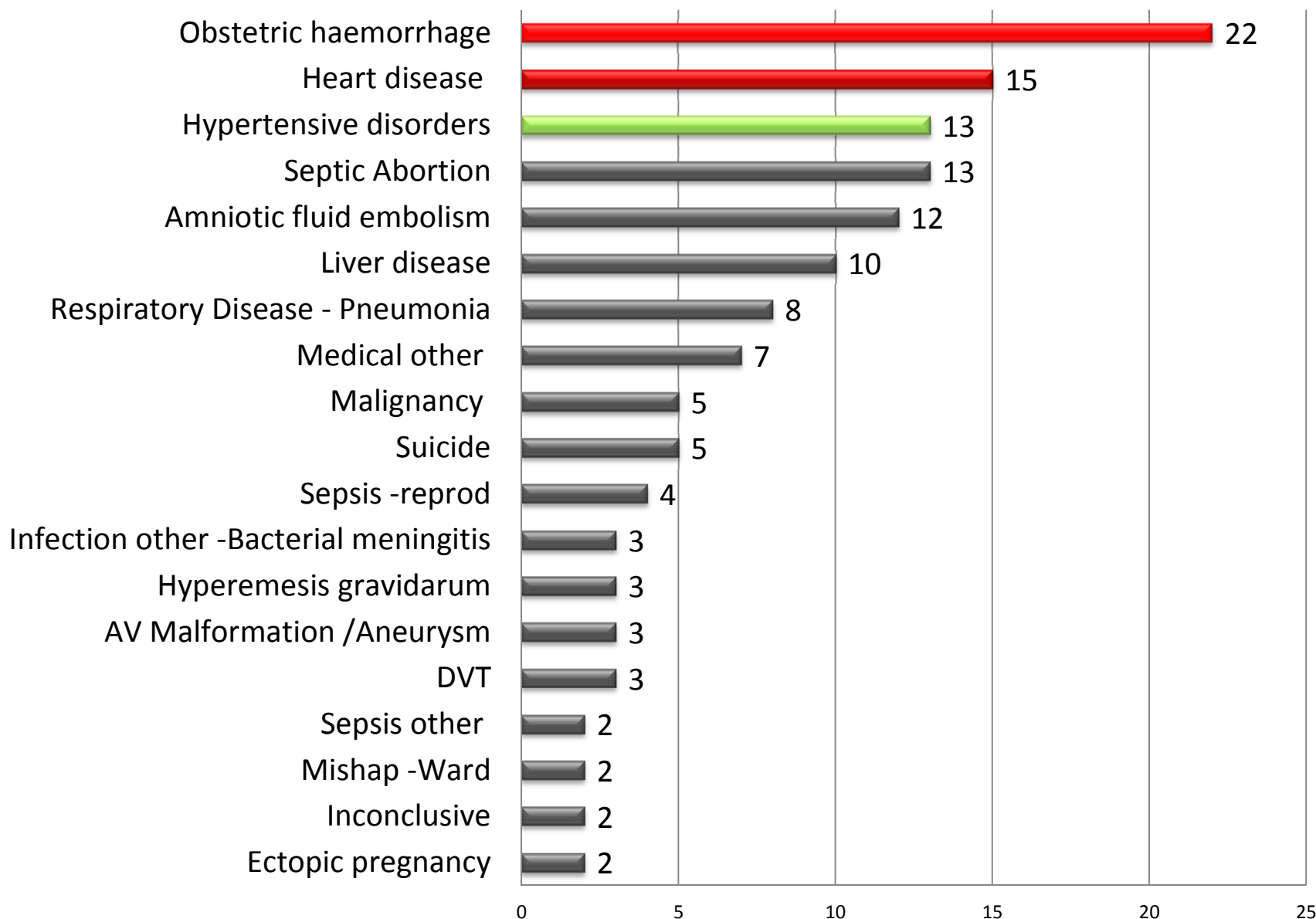
